CONDITIONS OF CONSIGNMENT

1. Only financial members may offer goods for sale at the Art House. A member will be deemed unfinancial if renewal fees are not paid by 1st October.
2. The hanging and arranging of art works will only be done by the designated team. The display will be refreshed every 3 months and if not sold your pieces may be removed. When dropping off paintings you would like hung, record all works in the register with as much information as possible. Then place the works in the designated area in the storeroom.
3. The consignor should note that while every care will be taken of goods consigned for sale, it is the consignor's responsibility to insure their own goods, as the Art House insurance does not cover consignor's items offered for sale.
4. The sales area will be staffed by members on a roster basis. Participation in the roster will be encouraged but is not a formal requirement for the acceptance of goods for sale.
5. The Committee reserves the right to accept or reject goods offered for sale.
6. Consignors are required to price their own goods for sale. After sale, a commission will be deducted from the figure nominated by consignor.
7. Commission will be 20% of the sale price.
8. Payments will be made monthly, within the first week of the calendar month after which the goods were sold.
